Financial Summary

We had a strong year with both our programmatic impact and fundraising efforts! We raised more funds than we did in 2024, and exceeded our year-end fundraising target by over \$3,500. We are in a good position to keep the momentum going into 2025 with our fish farming pilot initiative and will continue to invest in our other programs as well!

Statement of Faith
